The statewide general election will be held on November 3, 2020. The District has three director terms expiring; Director Griffin and Stone for 4 year terms. Director Brister for 2 year term. Their terms of office will expire December 5, 2020.

Candidate filing begins on July 13, 2020 and ends at 5:00 pm on August 7, 2020. The San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters will offer contact-free services to candidates with a new My Candidacy Gateway web application and video conference appointments. There are approximately 300 local offices up for election in San Bernardino County with limited appointment times so expect the last week of filing to be very limited.

ROV announces contactless services to candidates



The San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters announces it will offer contact-free services to candidates with a new My Candidacy Gateway web application and video conference appointments.

My Candidacy Gateway is available on the Registrar of Voters website at SBCountyElections.com.

Citizens interested in running for school or special district offices in the November 3, 2020 Presidential General Election can use the application to begin the candidate filing process and schedule an appointment to file candidacy documents.

For the health and safety of candidates and staff alike, candidates are required to schedule appointments for candidate-filing services. My Candidacy Gateway provides candidates with the option to schedule a video conference or in-person appointment. In addition, candidates that use My Candidacy Gateway will have candidacy documents prepared in advance of their appointment.

Candidate filing for the November 3, 2020 Presidential General Election begins Monday, July 13 and continues through 5 p.m. on Friday, August 7. Appointments are available Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. In-person appointments will be conducted at the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters, 777 E. Rialto Avenue in San Bernardino.

There are approximately 300 local offices up for election in San Bernardino County, including school district, special district and city offices. For a complete list of districts with offices up for election, visit SBCountyElections.com.

Citizens interested in running for city offices up for election must pick up and file their candidate filing documents at the appropriate City Clerk's office during regular business hours.
